Jerayme,

I am writing to let you know about my experience with your product. I run a fleet of trucks that haul wood chips from the local lumber mills to the paper mills in the area. The majority of these trailers have three axles and run the 385/65R22.5 super single tires. When supply demands we run our trucks around the clock. We would go into the lumber mills and pickup nails and foreign objects in the tread face of our tires. The tires would not go flat immediately. It always seemed like the trucks would get 60 to 100 miles out and invariably sometimes 2 or 3 times a week on our night runs we were having issues. Because of the drivers inability to see low tires running down the road while it was dark the tires would run losing air until they failed. We were frequently experiencing costly down time and expensive night calls, not to mention the destruction of very expensive wide base aluminum wheels and tires run beyond recognition. Upon inspection of the failed tires we would find nails or screws or some other piece of metal in the tire that had caused air loss, the tire had run until it failed from being run low.

Our account salesmen from GCR Tire Center recommended we give your product a try. We first put it in two of our trailers and then monitored it. After about 3 weeks of having no problems with those trailers I made the decision to have Multi Seal installed in all the tires on these trailers as they as they came up for replacement. That was well over 2 years ago, your product is in every one of those trailer tires and I am happy to say I can't remember the last time we had an issue. The product does everything my GCR Tire Center salesmen said it would. Your product now goes in every new and retreaded tire running on those trailers.
